NOTES

- Scores of 3 or lower are not accepted for any credit.
- Students matriculating <u>before</u> Fall 2016 could receive equivalency for either BIO 201 or BIO 202 via the AP biology test. Default credit for BIO 202 was assigned.
- A maximum of 8 hours of credit will be granted for the combination of the two exams in Calculus.
- Credit awarded for Physics C tests (Mechanics & Electricity/Magnetism) is dependent on Department assessment.
- Effective 2012, Latin Literature and Latin Vergil were combined into one course and test.
- Effective 2014, Physics B was divided into Physics 1 and Physics 2.
- Effective 2015, Computer Science A & B will no longer be accepted.
- Generally, elective credit awarded for AP does not count toward the major or minor in a discipline (e.g., ENG, HST, POL), but rather as general credit that can be applied toward graduation. If specific course equivalency is granted, however, such might count toward a major or minor, depending on the specific course requirements for the major or minor. See the Catalog for more information.
- Where the number of credits awarded exceeds the credit hours of any specific course equivalency, the balance of credits will be elective within the subject.
- Students must take the Hillsdale College language placement test in the subject for which AP credit is desired. Any credit and equivalency awarded will be below the course level into which the student places. Example: Student places into SPN 201 = Credit and equivalency for SPN 101 & 102.
- Credit for the same specific course can, in most cases, be granted only once. Therefore, Advanced Placement, International
 Baccalaureate, transfer and institutional work will be considered in total in determining credit and equivalencies awarded.
 Generally, institutional credit will supersede or cancel other credit.
