- Note: The examinations on this list are the only CLEP tests for which credit will be granted at Hillsdale College.
- A student cannot receive more than four hours of credit per language based on CLEP results. Regardless of a student's performance on the CLEP test, credit will not be granted for a level higher than or equal to the level at which a student scores on the Hillsdale College Language Placement Test. The Language CLEP test must be taken during the first semester of enrollment at Hillsdale. If more than 4 hours of language credit will be transferred or granted via Advanced Placement, the student may not take the CLEP test in that language.
- Credit for the same specific course can, in most cases, be granted only once. Therefore, Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, transfer and institutional work will be considered in total in determining credit and equivalencies awarded. Generally, institutional credit will supersede or cancel other credit.
